How to make an appointment?

- See the Counsellor/Youth Ministry Coordinator or Careers coordinator before school, at recess or lunch to organise an appointment – write the appointment in your diary.
- If the appointment is during class time show the teacher your diary before class starts and then politely excuse yourself at the appropriate time
- If you are having regular sessions ensure that the same subject is not missed consistently

- Do not make appointments that cause you to miss any assessment task unless it is an emergency
- In urgent/emergency cases see the Year Leader, Director of Pastoral Care and Wellbeing, Director of Students or Assistant Principal and an appointment will be organised as soon as possible
- Parents that would like to speak to a support coordinator should contact the College.
