COVID UPDATE FOR WEEK 1 TERM 3

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

The NSW Premier announced this morning that the current lockdown will be extended until midnight Friday 16 July. The intent of this extended lockdown is to minimise mobility of as many people in the Greater Sydney area as possible.

This decision affects all Catholic Schools in Broken Bay (CSBB).

For the week beginning Monday 12th July, CSBB will be open to supervise students who need to attend. In order for teachers to meet and prepare home-based learning, there will be no formal teaching on Monday. Home-based learning will be provided from Tuesday 13th July through until Friday 16th July. Students who need to be at school during next week will be welcomed.

Parents are not permitted on site, unless it is essential, for example to collect IT equipment or other materials to enable home-based learning.

Year 12 students are permitted on site if required. Your school will provide further information in this regard.

We are mindful of the impact that this extended lockdown may have on some families and its impact on their ability to pay school fees. If you are experiencing any financial difficulty and need assistance with your child's school fees please contact your school principal or the Fees Liaison Unit (9847 0728 or schoolfees@dbb.org.au).
