Acknowledgement of Country


We walk together in footsteps millennia old.

God help us to bear witness To the mystery of the cross and resurrection So we may be people of integrity and justice, Walking in the footsteps of Christ your son.









Did you know that you can set up the same for your child's phone?




• Mobile Phone and Device Policy -
